



STEERING WHEEL

1. CHECK STEERING WHEEL FREEPLAY

- (a) Stop the vehicle and face the tires straight ahead.
- (b) Rock the steering wheel gently up and down with a finger lightly, check the steering wheel freeplay.
 Maximum free play: 30 mm (1.18 in.)

2. CHECK STEERING EFFORT

- (a) Center the steering wheel.
- (b) Remove the steering wheel pad (See page SR-10).
- (c) Start the engine and run it at idle.
- (d) Measure the steering effort in both directions.
 Steering effort (Reference):
 6.5 N-m (65 kgf-cm, 58 in.-lbf)

HINT:

Take the tire type, pressure and contact surface into consideration before making your diagnosis.

- (e) Install the steering wheel set nut.Torque: 34 N·m (350 kgf·cm, 25 ft·lbf)
- (f) Install the steering wheel pad (See page SR-19).
